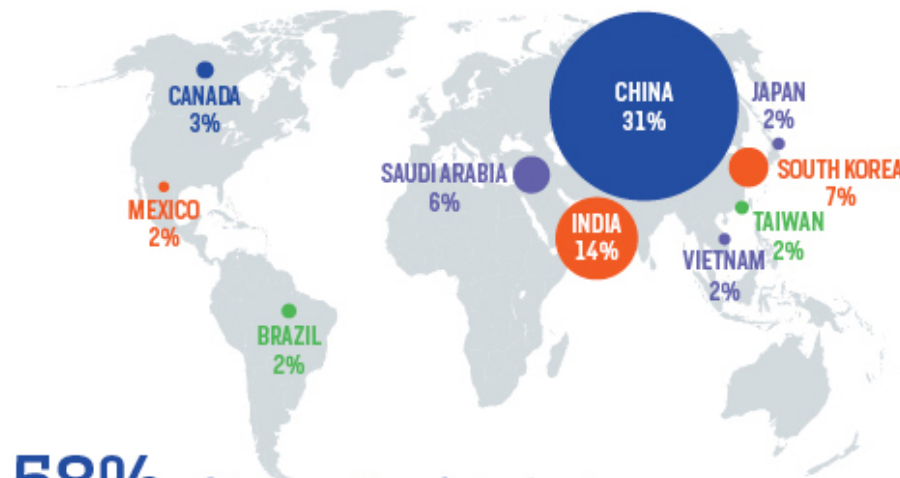

God opened the door, but it could be closed tomorrow

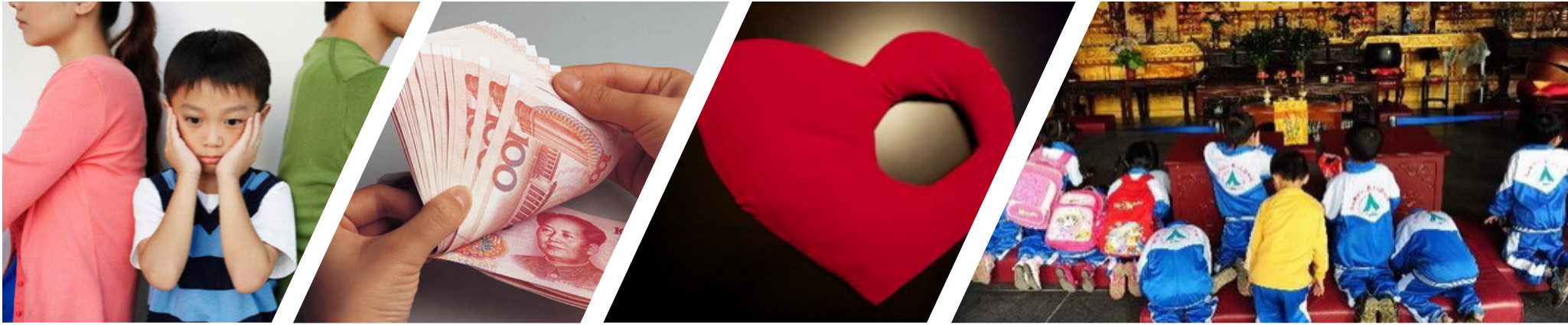
TOP TEN PLACES OF ORIGIN OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

come from China, India, South Korea, and Saudi Arabia.

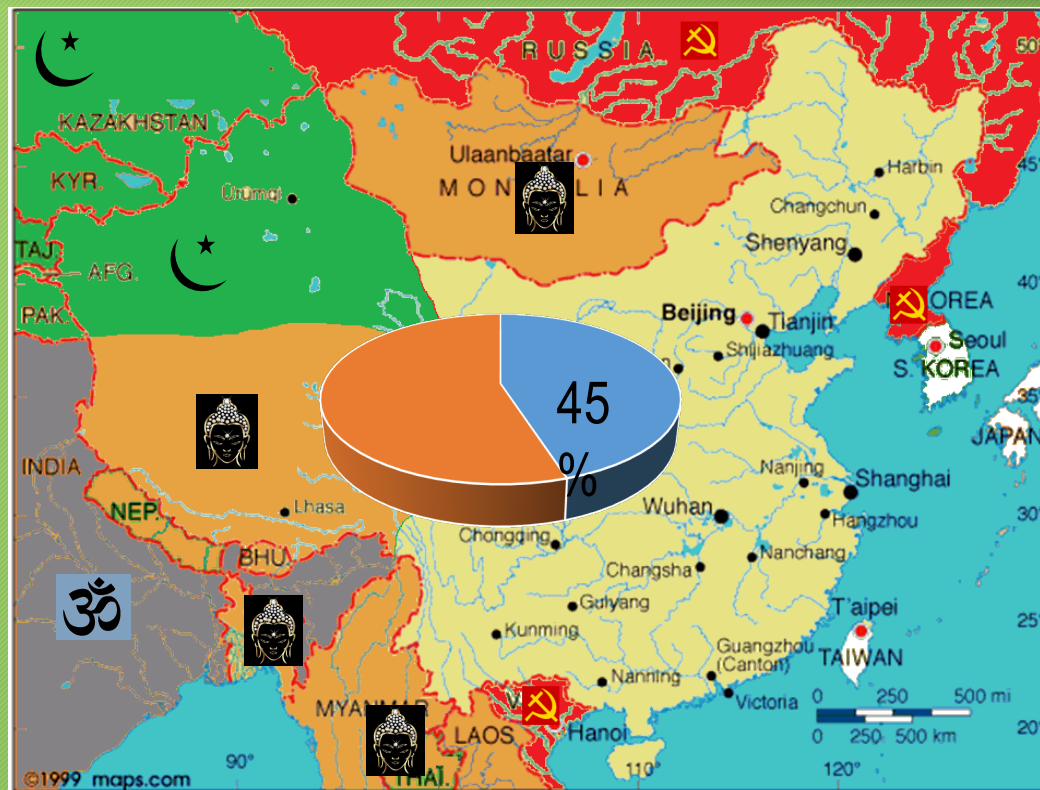
